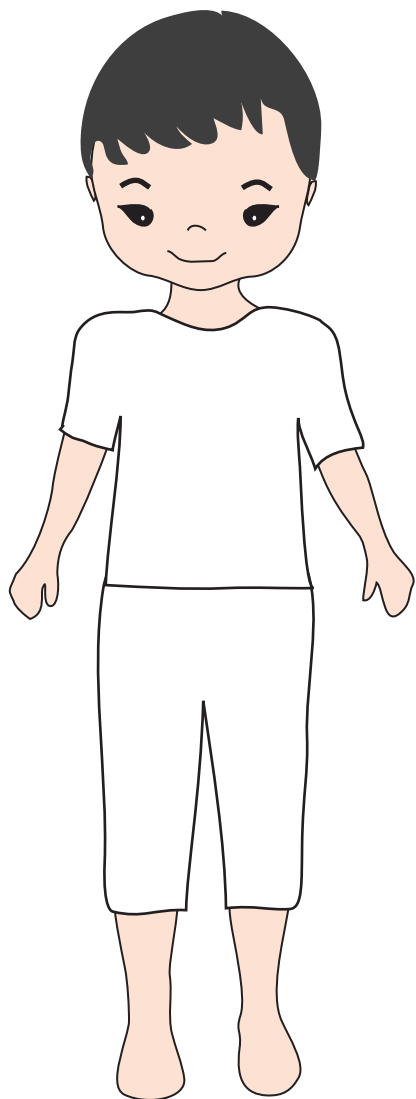


Inuvialuit Paper Dolls

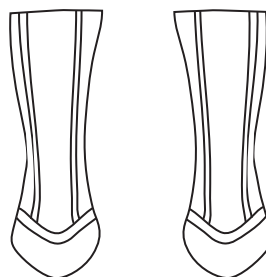

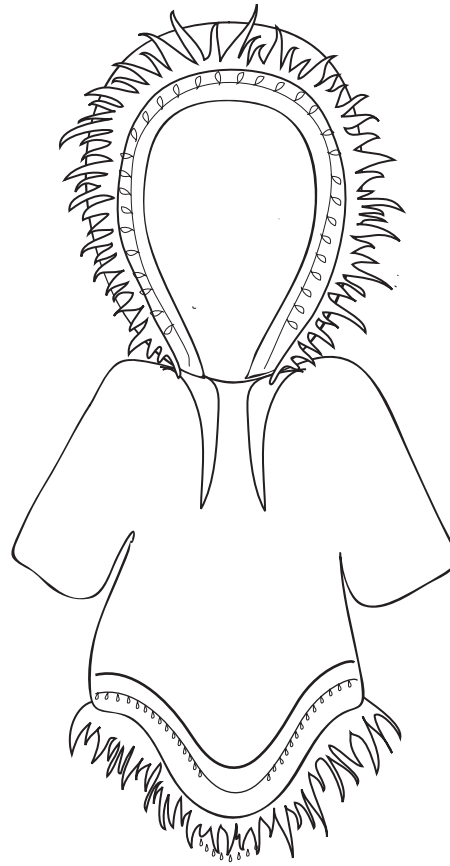
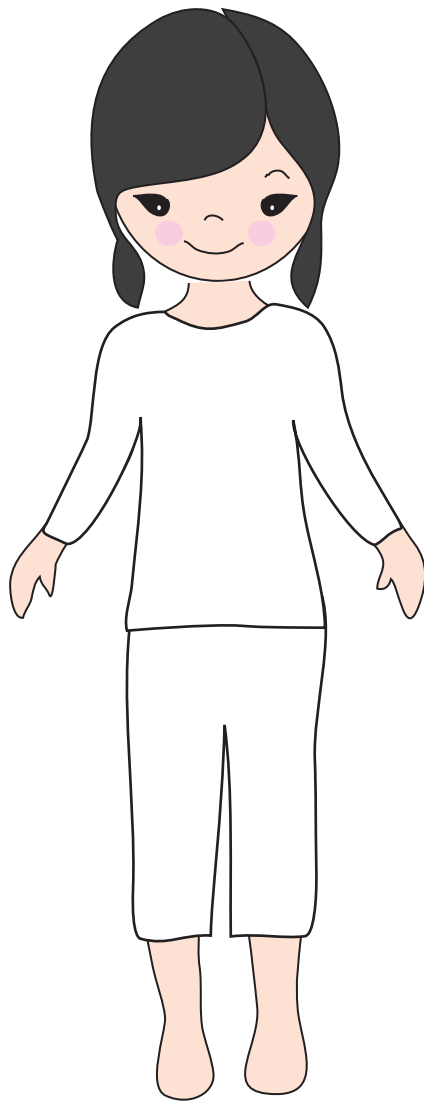

5. Model your doll to an audience



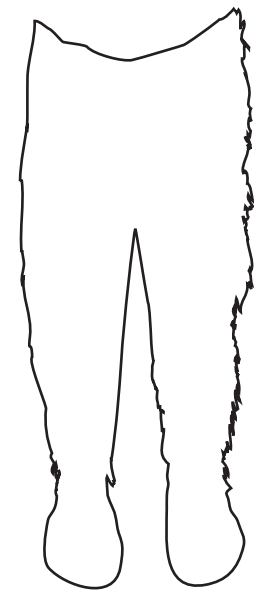
